Providence House Minot aims to bridge this gap by providing specialized services.

The treatment center is currently open to women and pregnant women, but to accommodate women with children, an administration building is needed. This building will allow for onsite daycare and counseling services for children and their mothers. The project requires \$1,500,000.00 in funding, and the Providence Foundation of North Dakota is committed to developing financial partnerships over the next 18 months to complete it.
